The WebAssign homework serves as the post lecture homework assignments. A total of five attempts are allotted for each assignment. One note about WebAssign is that significant figures are graded. A correct answer with the incorrect number of significant figures will be awarded 90% credit.

WebAssign will be due every Thursday at 11:59 pm.

Like Eduspace, students will also self register for WebAssign. The WebAssign groups are broken up according to the specific sections, and once again a course code and access code is needed for WebAssign registration.




If no prior webassign account have been created, a new account must be created. The following information should be completed. Write down your username etc. because this will be needed each time WebAssign is accessed.
